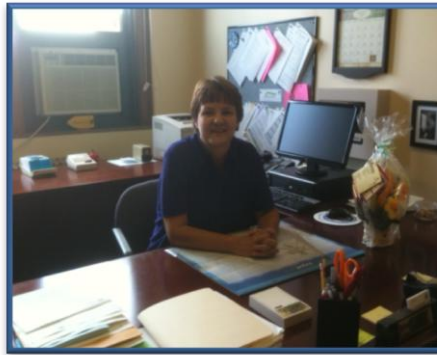

## Welcome to St. Joseph School

St. Joseph School is a vibrant, Catholic community for students in grades K-8. The U.S. Department of Education has named St. Joseph School a **Blue Ribbon School of Excellence**, the highest honor a school can receive. The school enriches its core curriculum with Spanish classes for all grades, art taught by a certified art teacher, comprehensive music program, band for grades 5-8, physical education, a complete sports program, Christmas and spring concerts, and an annual play. Supported by a state-of-the-art computer lab, technology is integrated in all subject areas.

**Admissions Policy** The admissions policy of St. Joseph School is in accordance with the student acceptance regulations of the Diocese of Cleveland.

The school admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at St. Joseph School.



**Tuition** The subsidized tuition rate for the children of parishioners is **\$2975 (\$247.92 per month)** for the 2012-2013 school year. This is regularly the largest amount of financial aid awarded except in cases of true financial need. There is a family plan for members of the parish with two or more children in the school.

**Service Projects** The driving force of St. Joseph School is living our mission statement. Shaping service-minded Catholics is a priority. All classrooms have regular service projects such as visiting nursing homes, writing letters to our troops, making cards for hospice patients, supporting children in Third World Countries, and donating money and goods to Pregnancy Care, Akron Children's Hospital, St Bernard's Hunger Center, Catholic Relief Services, and many other charities.

All the service projects are grade appropriate and instill in the children the belief in and necessity of serving others and the joy of giving.

**School Community** A dedicated, committed, and caring administration, faculty, and staff are essential to the success of the school. In order to help all students reach their full potential, St. Joseph School provides extensive tutoring, language, and speech development, and counseling and psychological services.
